
Let's prep the side table. Attach Hinge (13) to the Rear Side Panel (E).

Align Side Panel (O) with Rear Side Panel (E) and secure Long Bolt (3) with supplied Allen key (8).






Tighten bolts halfway



Align one Connecting Bar (F) between Rear Side Panels (M, E) and secure Small Bolt (1) with supplied Allen key (8). Repeat between Side Panels (N, O).




Align one Connecting Panel (K) between Side Panels (M, E) and secure Long Bolt (3) with supplied Allen key (8). Repeat between Side Panels (N, O).



Tighten bolts halfway




Align Angled Support Bar (G) between Connecting Bar (F) and Connecting Panel (K), with adjustment brackets facing upwards, and secure Small Bolt (1) with supplied Allen key (8).






STEP 16
