#### Unlock the Packaging Locks



- Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees counterclockwise.
  - Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

## **GETTING STARTED**

### **Battery Removal and Installation**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)

5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

## ⚠ WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

## **ATTENTION**:

#### IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the tov.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

#### RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

#### 1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the Low volume 
or High volume 
or High volume 
or Position. You will hear sounds, a phrase and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the **Off** 
or position.



#### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Explore & Move With Puppy™** will automatically power down after approximately 25 seconds without input. The unit can be turned On again by pressing the Heart Button.

#### NOTE

This product is in try-me mode in the packaging. To activate normal play, turn the unit **Off**, then turn the unit back **On**. If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

## **ACTIVITIES**

#### 1. Heart Button

Press the **Heart Button** to learn about the puppy, feelings and numbers, and hear puppy sounds, melodies and songs. The light will flash with the sound.

## **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- 5. The puppy is surface washable only.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
