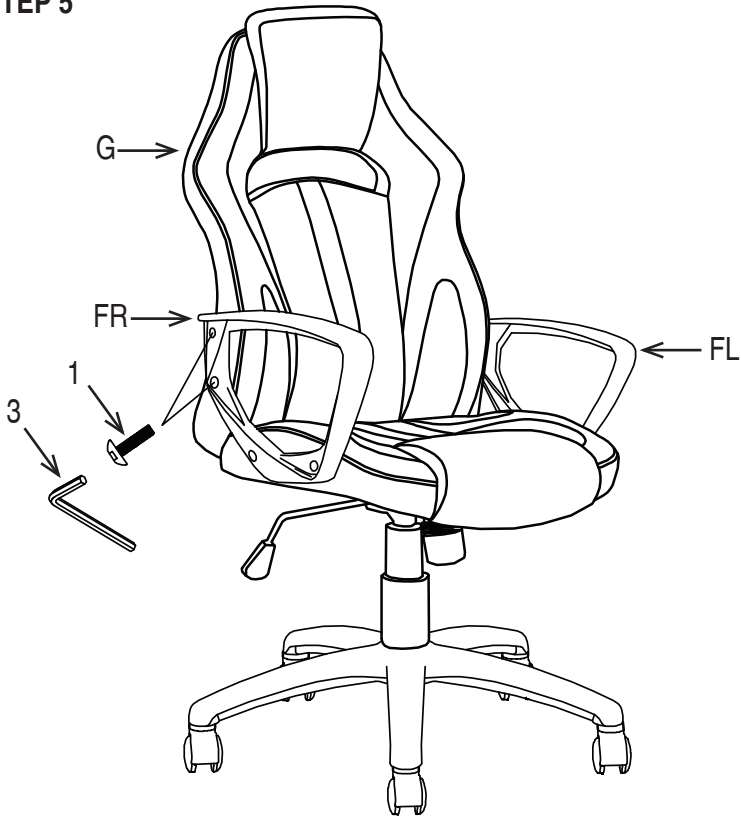
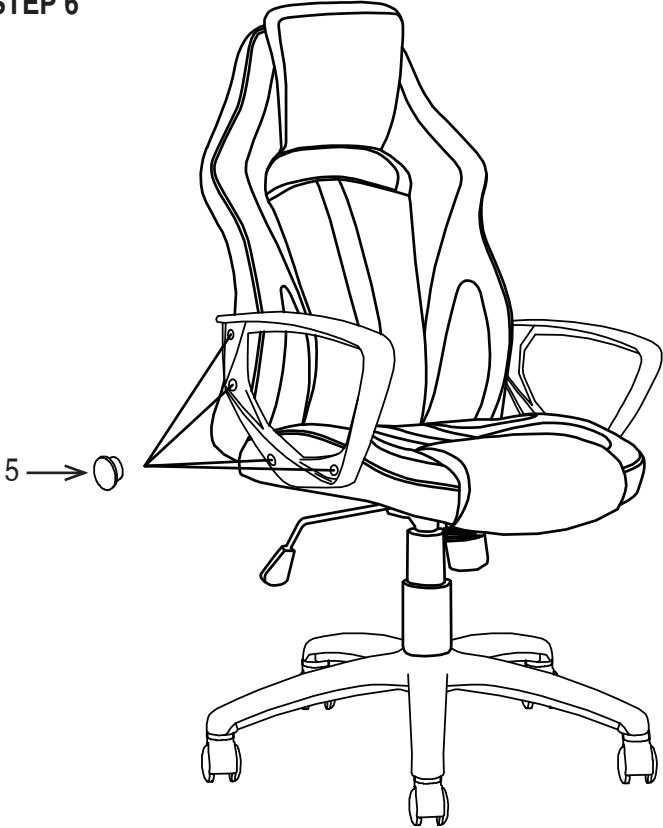

STEP 5 Carefully slide Back Cushion (G) between Arms (FL & FR) and secure using two Screws (1) for each Arm (F). **APPLY FIRM PRESSURE TO ALIGN & FULLY TIGHTEN ALL SCREWS USING ALLEN WRENCH (3).**
STEP 6 Cover holes in Arms (FL & FR) using four Plastic Caps (5) for each Arm (F).
ATTENTION: MAKE SURE ALL BOLTS ARE FULLY TIGHTENE BEFORE USING CHAIR.

FEATURES

- **PNEUMATIC SEAT HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT**
To raise seat remove pressure from seat and pull lever (1) up.
To lower seat height sit on chair and pull lever (1) up.
NOTE: It is normal for chair to slightly lower under body weight.
- **LOCKING TILT ADJUSTMENT**
For individual comfort, this chair has been equipped with an adjustment that will allow the user to change the tension of the tilting feature. Turn knob (2) clockwise to increase tension and counter-clockwise to decrease or ease the tension. To lock return chair to the upright position and push lever (1) in. To unlock pull lever (1) out.
NOTE: Be careful not to loosen back tilt adjustment knob completely.

WARNING

1. Use this product only one person at a time.
2. Do not use this chair unless all bolts screws and knobs are securely tightened.
3. Check that all bolts screws and knobs are tight every three months or as needed.
4. Do not overturn back tilt knob when decreasing tension.
5. Dispose of packing material properly. Do not use plastic cover as head covering. It may cause suffocation.
6. Do not use chair as a stepladder.
7. Use this chair for its intended purpose only.
8. Use mild detergent only for cleaning.

STEP 1

Diagram showing the assembly of the base. Casters (A) are inserted into the base (B). The pneumatic cylinder (C) is inserted into the base, and the bellows (D) are slipped over the cylinder.

STEP 2

Diagram showing the attachment of the seat plate (E) to the seat cushion (H). Four flat washers (4) and four bolts (2) are used to secure the seat plate to the seat cushion.

STEP 3

Diagram showing the assembled seat (H) being placed on top of the pneumatic cylinder (C) and applying downward pressure.

STEP 4

Diagram showing the attachment of the arms (FL & FR) to the seat cushion (H) using two bolts (1) for each arm. The Allen wrench (3) is used to tighten the bolts.

Remove all parts from carton, separate by part numbers indicated on parts list, and verify part quantities.

STEP 1 Insert five Casters (A) into Base (B), push hard until you feel or hear the Caster (A) snap into place. Insert Pneumatic Cylinder (C) into Base (B) and slip Bellows (D) over Pneumatic Cylinder (C).

STEP 2 Attach Seat Plate (E) to Seat Cushion (H) using four Flat Washers (4) and four Bolts (2) **FULLY TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS (2) USING ALLEN WRENCH (3).**

STEP 3 Place the assembled seat on top of Pneumatic Cylinder (C) and apply downward pressure.

STEP 4 Attach Arms (FL & F2) to Seat Cushion (H) using two Bolts (1) for each Arm (F). **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.**
