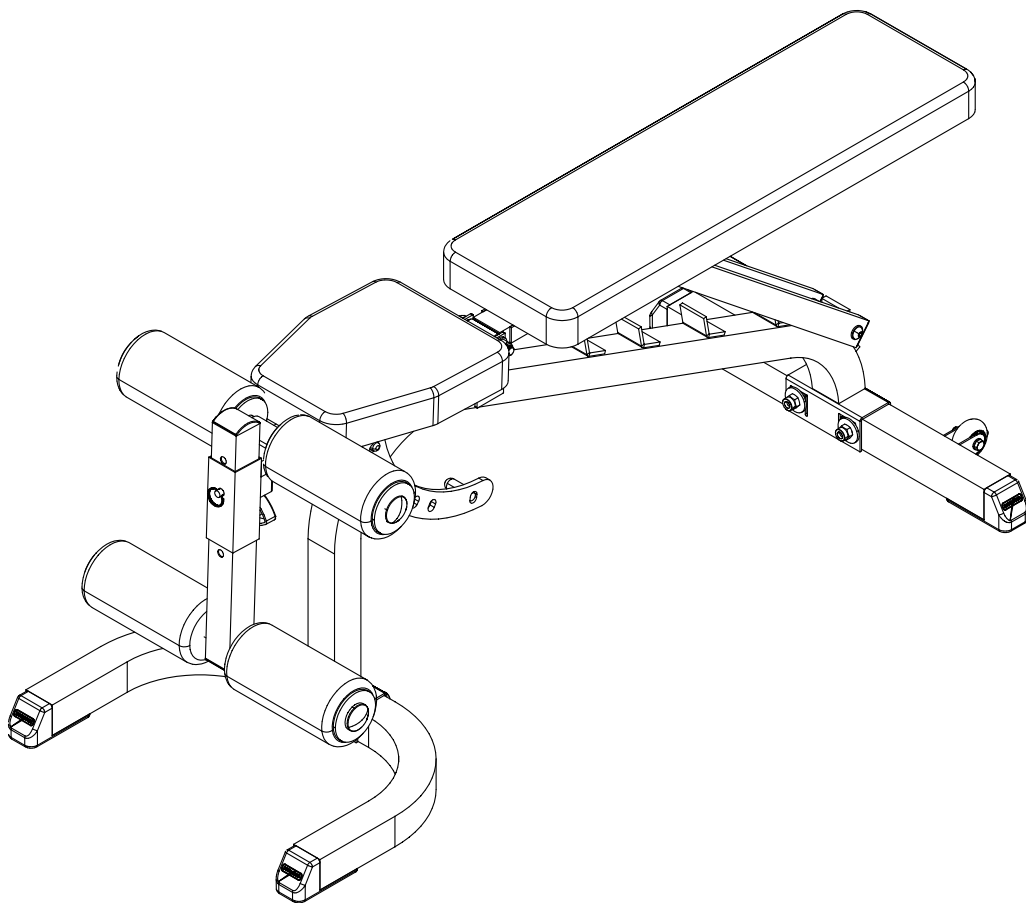

Warning, Safety & Maintenance

THERE IS A RISK ASSUMED BY INDIVIDUALS WHO USE THIS TYPE OF EQUIPMENT. TO MINIMIZE RISK, YOU MUST FOLLOW THESE RULES:

Inspect equipment before each workout. Check that all nuts, bolts, screws and pop pins are in place and fully tightened. Also, before use, check cables for sign of wear. Replace all worn parts immediately. Never use machine if any parts are damaged or missing.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.

Keep clear of the cables and all moving parts when machine is in use. Always make sure all Snap Links are closed when doing cable/pulley/strap exercises. Exercise with care. Perform your exercises at a smooth moderate pace; never perform jerky or uncoordinated movements that may cause injury.

It is recommended that you workout with a training partner.

Do not allow children or minors to play on or around this equipment.

If unsure of proper use of equipment, call your local Body-Solid distributor or the Body-Solid customer service center at 1-800-556-3113.

WARNING: Consult your physician before starting your exercise program. For your own safety, do not begin any exercise program without proper instruction.

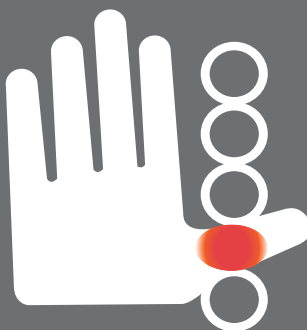

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Important Safety Instructions

Before beginning any fitness program, you should obtain a complete physical examination from your physician.

- Read all instructions before using the GFID-31. These instructions are written to ensure your safety and to protect the unit.
- Do not allow children on or near the equipment.
- Use the equipment only for its intended purpose as described in this guide. Do not use accessory attachments that are not recommended by the manufacturer. Such attachments might cause injuries.
- Wear proper exercise clothing and shoes for your workout, no loose clothing.
- Use care when getting on or off the unit.
- Do not overexert yourself or work to exhaustion.
- If you feel any pain or abnormal symptoms, stop your workout immediately and consult your physician.
- Never operate unit when it has been dropped or damaged. Return the equipment to a service center for examination and repair.
- Never drop or insert objects into any opening in the equipment.
- Always check the unit and its cables before each use. Make sure that all fasteners and cables are secure and in good working condition.
- Do not use the equipment outdoors or near water.

Personal Safety During Assembly

- Before beginning assembly, please take the time to read the instructions thoroughly.
- Read each step in the assembly instructions and follow the steps in sequence. Do not skip ahead. If you skip ahead, you may learn later that you have to disassemble components and that you may have damaged the equipment.
- Assemble and operate the GFID-31 on a solid, level surface. Locate the unit a few feet from the walls or furniture to provide easy access.

The GFID-31 is designed for your enjoyment. By following these precautions and using common sense, you will have many safe and pleasurable hours of healthful exercise with your Body-Solid GFID-31.

After assembly, you should check all functions to ensure correct operation. If you experience problems, first recheck the assembly instructions to locate any possible errors made during assembly. If you are unable to correct the problem, call the dealer from whom you purchased the machine or call 1-800-556-3113 for the dealer nearest you.

GFID-31 Preparation

Thank you for purchasing the GFID-31. This bench is part of the Body-Solid line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

Required Tools

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the GFID-31 include but are not limited to:

- Metric Allen Key Set
- Standard Allen Key Set
- Standard Wrench Set
- Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- Screwdriver (standard and/or phillips)
- Rubber Mallet

Installation Requirements

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the GFID-31:

Set up the GFID-31 on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level. A level machine has fewer malfunctions.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.

Assembly Tips

Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each step.

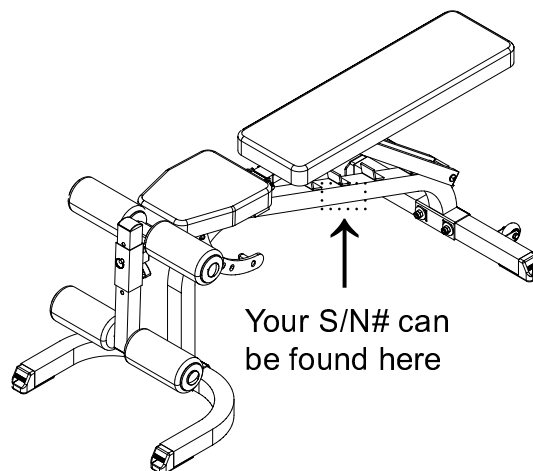
While you may be able to assemble the GFID-31 using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips are included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

NOTE: With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.

NOTE: The bottles that are marked "Poison" is your touch up paint. Keep away from children.

CAUTION: Obtain assistance! If you feel like you can't assemble the GFID-31 by yourself then do not attempt to do so as this could result in injury. Review the installation requirements before proceeding with the following steps.



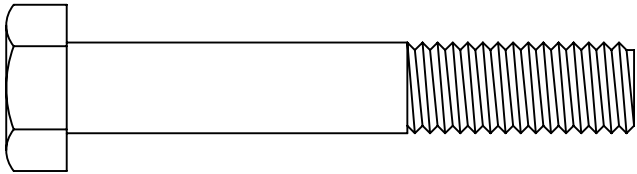

1

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

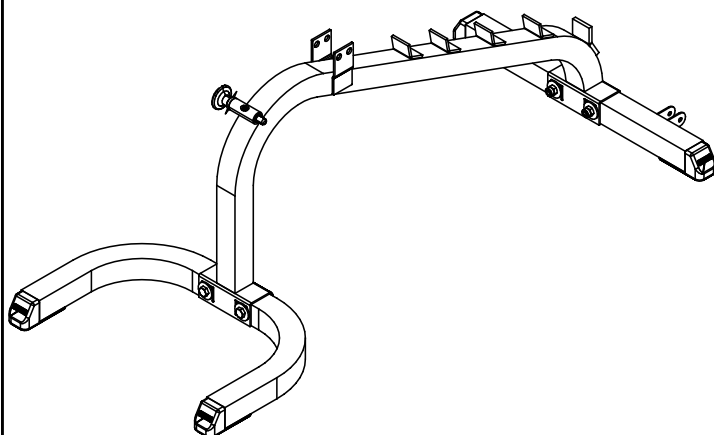
Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 1A. Attach Front Frame (I) to Mainframe (A) using:
 - 2 - (#1) M12X75mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 - (#9) M12 Washer
 - 2 - (#6) M12 Nylon Lock Nut

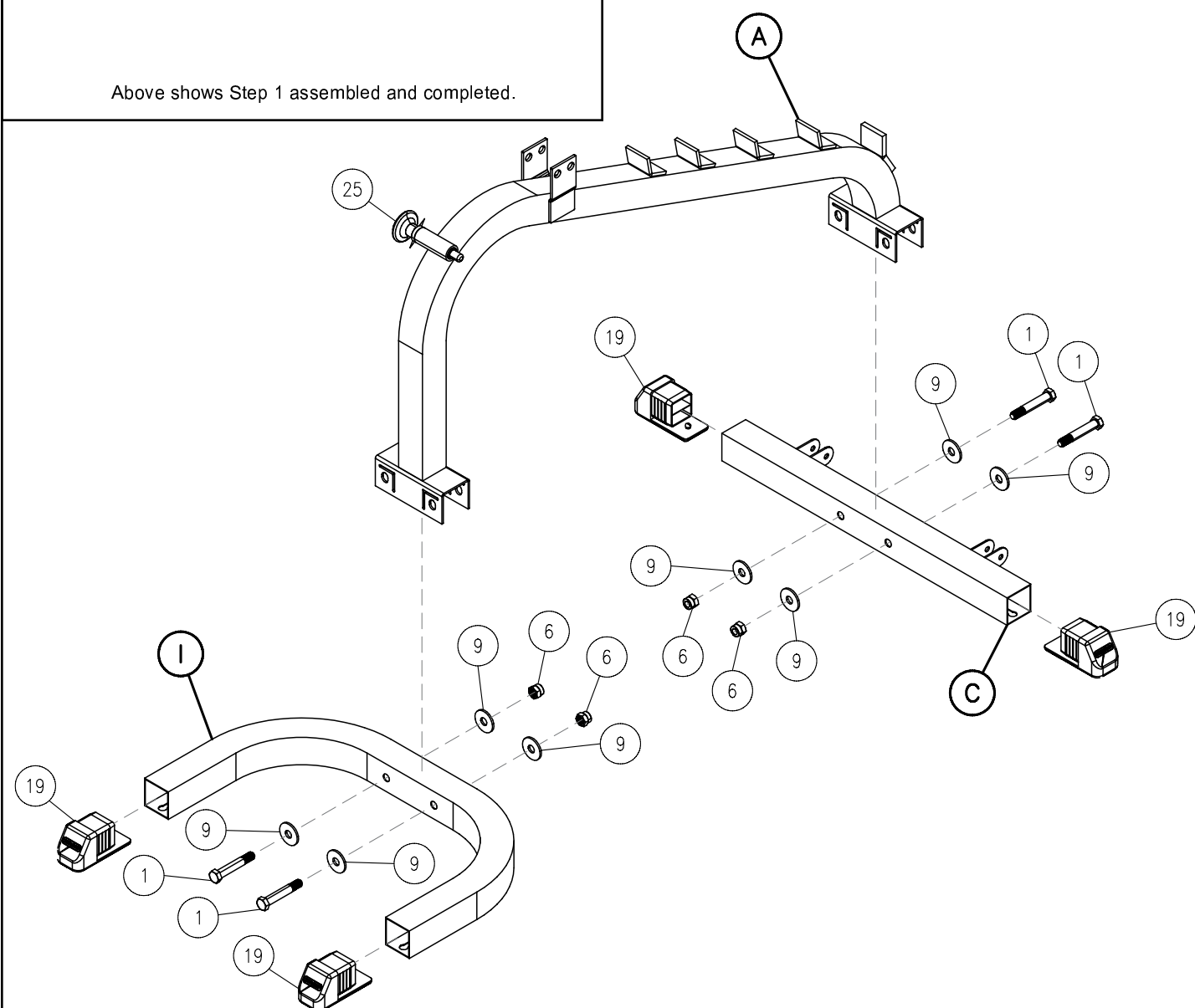
- 1B. Attach Rear Frame (C) to Mainframe (A) using:
 - 2 - (#1) M12X75mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 - (#9) M12 Washer
 - 2 - (#6) M12 Nylon Lock Nut

- 1C. Insert Foot Caps into ends of Front Frame (I) and Rear Frame (C) using:
 - 4 - (#19) 2"X2" Foot Cap

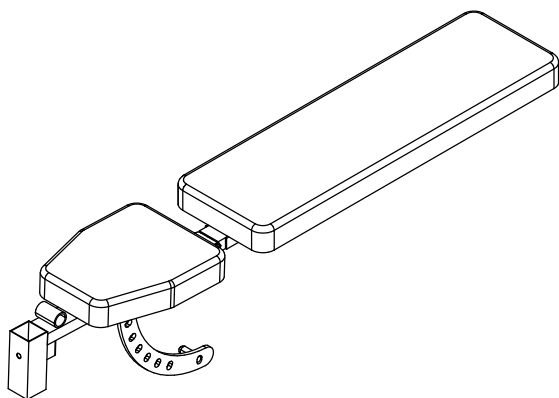

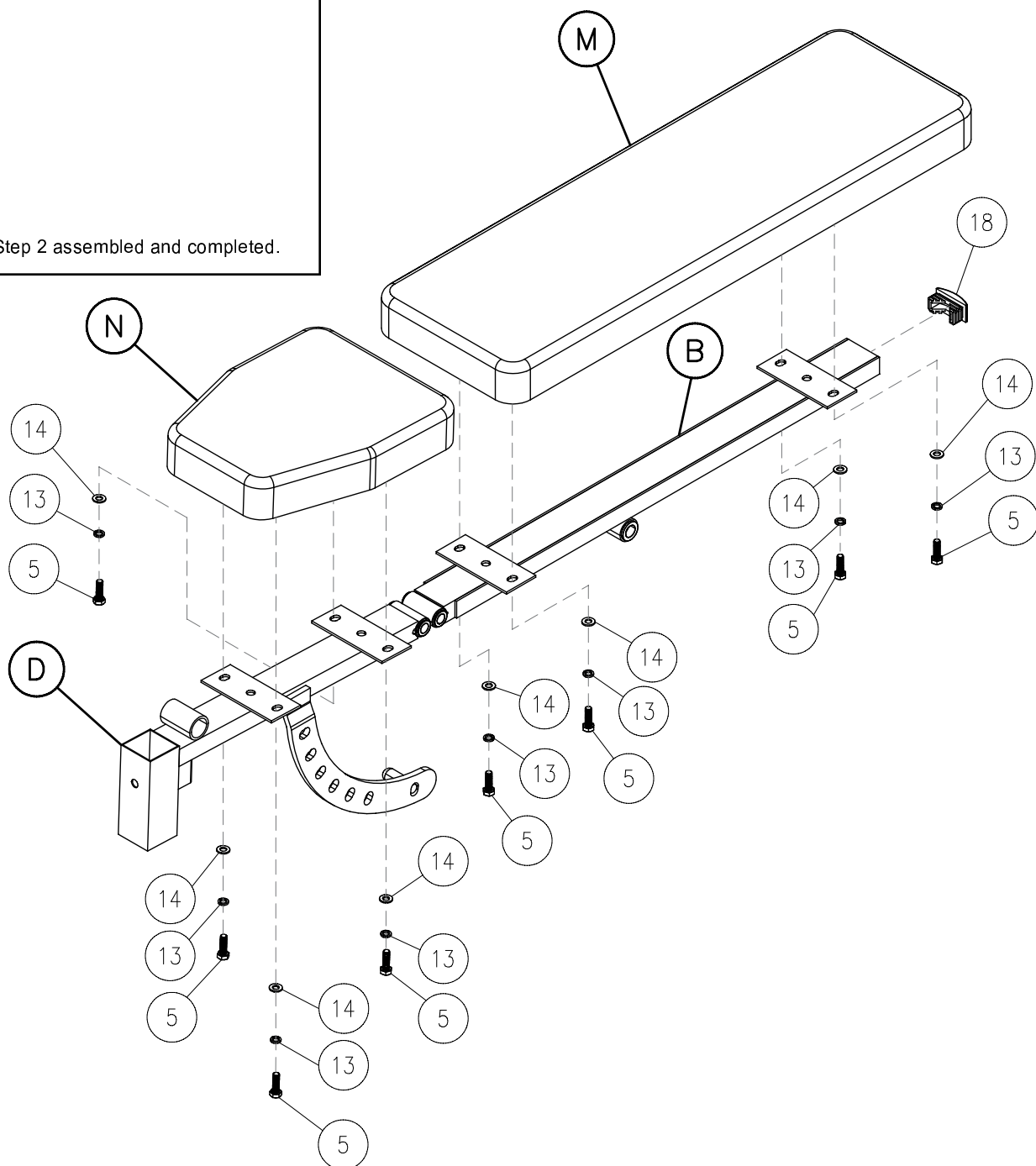
Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 2A. Attach Seat Pad (**N**) to Leg Frame (**D**) using:
- 4 - (#5) 5/16"X1" Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 - (#13) 5/16" Spring Washer
 - 4 - (#14) 5/16" Washer
- 2B. Attach Back Pad (**M**) to Back Frame (**B**) using:
- 4 - (#5) 5/16"X1" Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 - (#13) 5/16" Spring Washer
 - 4 - (#14) 5/16" Washer
- Note:** The holes that are farthest away from the edge on the Back Pad should be mounted to the rear of the Back Frame near the End Cap (#18).
- 2C. Insert End Cap into rear end of Back Frame (**B**) using:
- 1 - (#18) 1"X2" End Cap

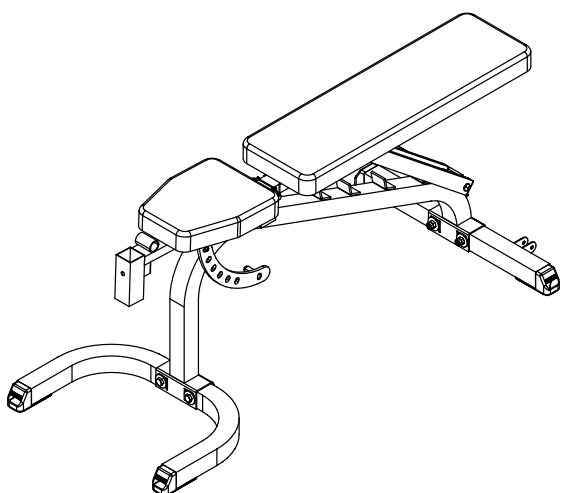

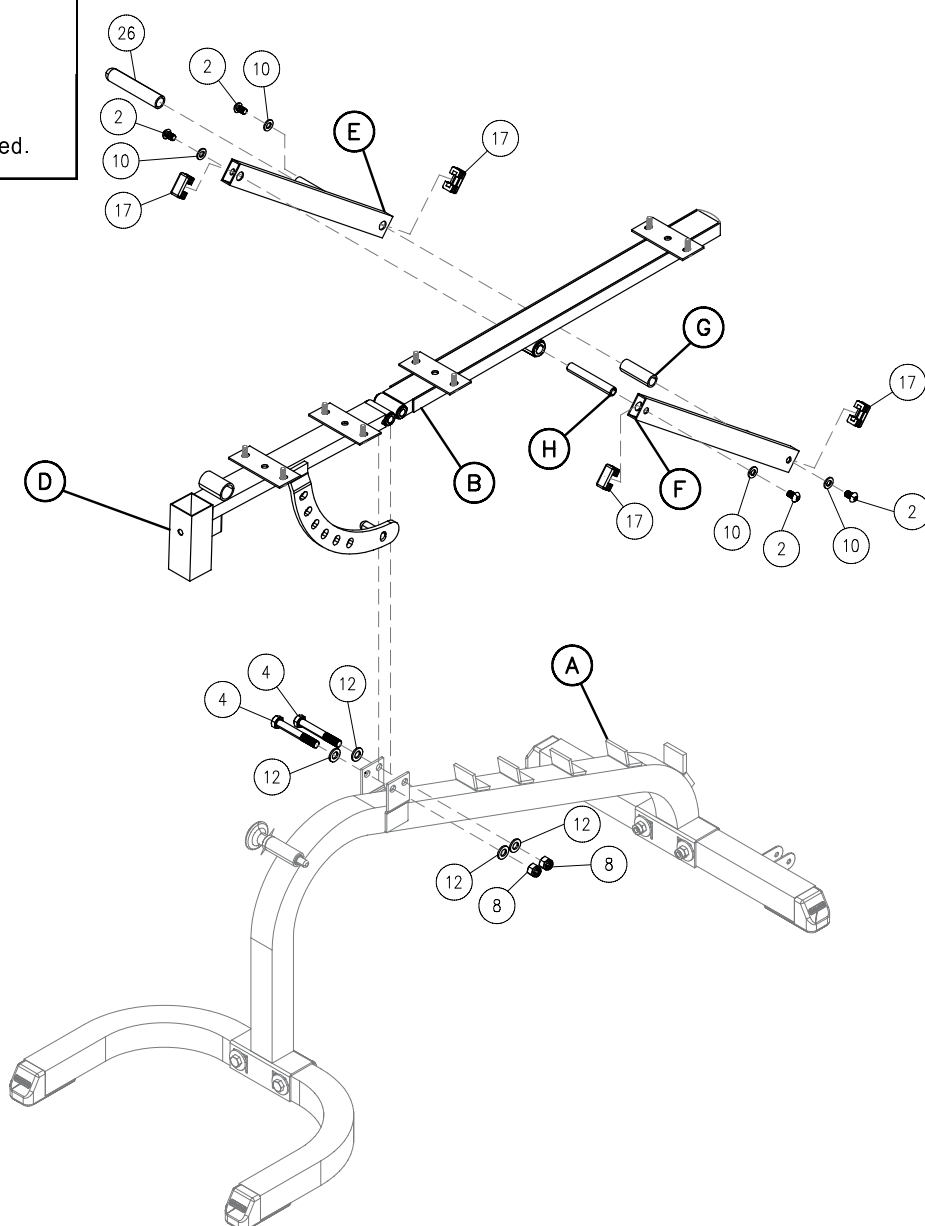
Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until the last step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

Note: Your GFID-31 more than likely will have parts E, H, F, and G already assembled to Back Frame (B) as well as the 20X40mm End Caps (#17). If it is assembled then only follow steps 3D and 3E otherwise follow all the steps. This step also doesn't show the Seat and Back pad to make instructions easier.

- 3A. Insert Plastic Sleeve (**G**) onto the rod of Incline Frame (**F**) and then attach Handle Frame (**E**) to Incline Frame (**F**) using:
 - 2 - (#2) M10X15mm Hex Head Bolt**
 - 2 - (#10) M10 Washer**
- 3B. Insert Incline Connector (**H**) into the round sleeve located on the bottom of Back Frame (**B**) and then attach both Handle Frame (**E**) and Incline Frame (**F**) to the connector using:
 - 2 - (#2) M10X15mm Hex Head Bolt**
 - 2 - (#10) M10 Washer**
- 3C. Insert End Caps into the ends of both Incline Frame (**F**) and Handle Frame (**E**) using:
 - 4 - (#17) 20X40mm End Caps**
- 3D. Attach Leg Frame (**D**) to Main Frame (**A**) using:
 - 1 - (#4) 1/2"X3" Hex Head Bolt**
 - 2 - (#12) 1/2" Washer**
 - 1 - (#8) 1/2" Nylon Lock Nut**
- 3E. Attach Back Frame (**B**) to Main Frame (**A**) using:
 - 1 - (#4) 1/2"X3" Hex Head Bolt**
 - 2 - (#12) 1/2" Washer**
 - 1 - (#8) 1/2" Nylon Lock Nut**
- 3C. Insert Foam Grip onto the Handle of Handle Frame (**E**) using:
 - 1 - (#26) Foam Grip**

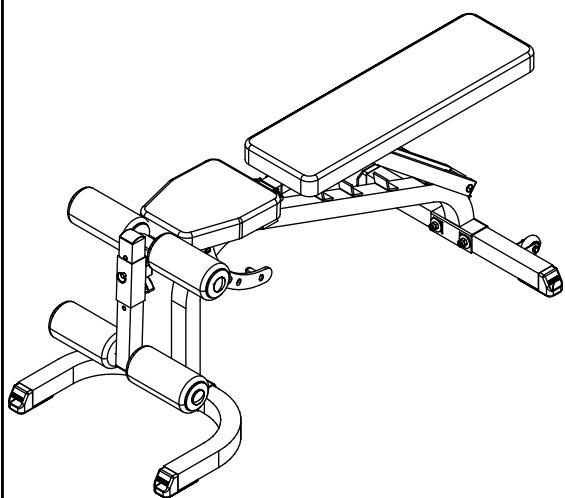
STEP**4**

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

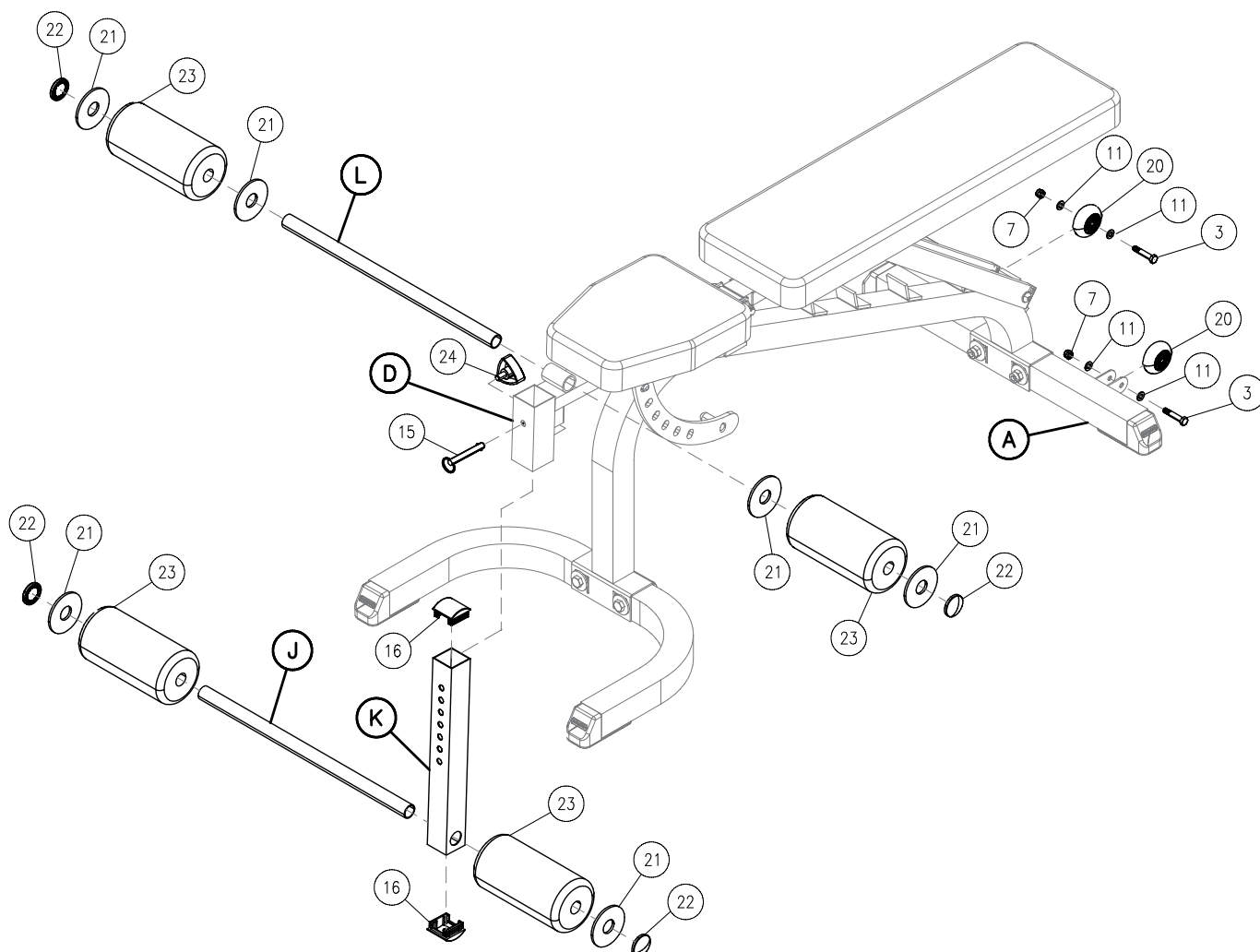
NOTE:

Wrench tighten all hardware at the end of this step. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 4A. Insert a End Cap into each end of Leg Adjuster (**K**) using:
2 - (#16) 45X45mm End Cap
- 4B. Insert Lower Rod (**J**) halfway into the larger round opening of Leg Adjuster (**K**). On each end of Lower Rod (**J**) insert a Foam Roller followed by a Nylon Washer and a Round End Cap using a total of:
2 - (#23) 3"X8" Foam Roller
2 - (#21) 3" Nylon Washer
2 - (#22) 1" Round End Cap
- 4C. Insert Upper Rod (**L**) halfway into the round slot on top of Leg Frame (**D**). On each end of Upper Rod (**L**) insert a Foam Roller followed by a Nylon Washer and a Round End Cap using a total of:
2 - (#23) 3"X8" Foam Roller
2 - (#21) 3" Nylon Washer
2 - (#22) 1" Round End Cap
- 4D. Insert Leg Adjuster (**K**) into Leg Frame (**D**) and secure using:
1 - (#15) Ring Pin
1 - (#24) Lock Pin
- 4E. Attach both Rubber Wheels to the rear of Mainframe (**A**) using a total of:
2 - (#20) 64mm Rubber Wheel
2 - (#3) M8X45mm Hex Head Bolt
4 - (#11) M8 Washer
2 - (#7) M8 Nylon Lock Nut

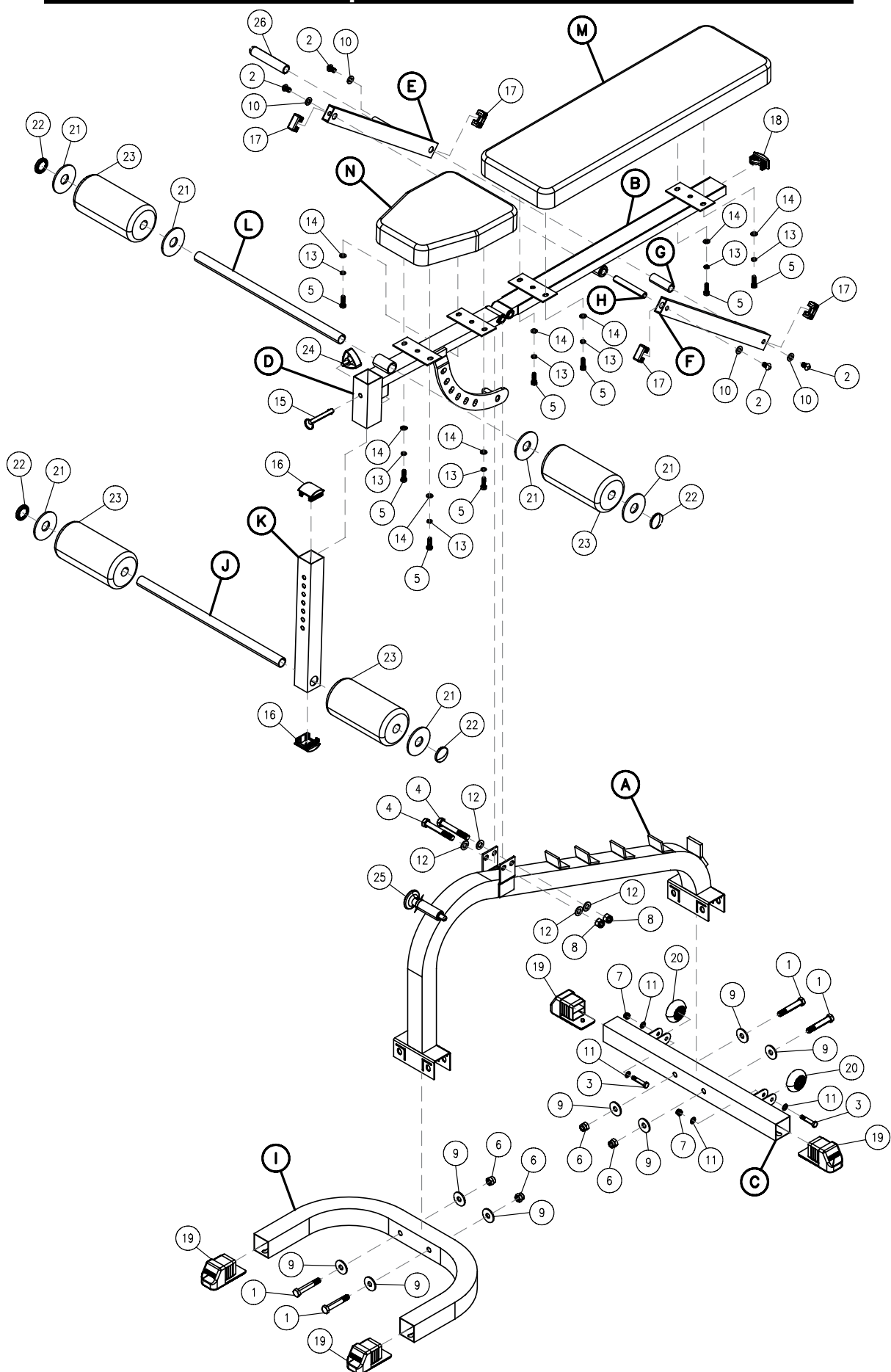


Above shows Step 4 assembled and completed.
