



Care Instructions

Granite is a natural stone material with naturally occurring fissures and cavities. A sealer has been applied to the granite to reduce the absorption of liquids. Even with sealer applied, liquids can absorb into the granite causing permanent stains. Never allow liquids to remain on the top. A stone sealer can be reapplied periodically to the granite to reduce the absorption of liquids.



Unpacking Instructions

STEP 1

Remove top carton.



STEP 2

Remove wood screws.

Remove upper wood supports by prying with a hammer. (See Figure 1)

Note: Do not hit top with hammer.





IMPORTANT


- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.




STEP 2

Attach Plinths (Q) and (S) to Base (P) with Head Cap Bolts. (See Figure 2)

Attach Leg Support (R) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.



Attach Side Panel (E) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.


Attach Back Rail (I) to unit with Cam Lock. (See Figure 3)

Attach Back Upright (J) to unit.

Slide Back Panels (K) into position.

Attach Back Rail (I) to unit with Cam Lock.

Attach Side Panel (G) to unit with Cam Locks and Head Cap Bolts.



STEP 4

Attach Side Panels (B) and (C) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.



STEP 5

Attach Side Panel (D) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.

Attach Front Rails (H1) and (H2) to unit with Cam Locks.

Attach Side Panel (F) to unit with Head Cap Bolts and Cam Locks.



Wood Screw for Hinge

STEP 6

Turn unit to its upright position.

Attach Back Supports (N) and (O) to unit with Wood Screws for Hinge. (See Figure 4)





STEP 7


Insert Adjustable Pins into side panels at desired level.

Place Shelves (L) and (M) into position.

Attach Doors (T) and (U) to unit by sliding door hinges into side panel hinges. (See Figure 5)


Attach Knobs to Doors (T) and (U) with Machine Screws. (See Figure 6)



Drawer (V)





STEP 8


Attach Drawer Front (V1) and Drawer Back (V2) to Drawer Side (V3) with Wood Screws (long).

Attach Drawer Side (V4) to unit with Wood Screws (long).

STEP 9


Slide Drawer Bottom (V5) into groove.


Attach Drawer Bottom (V5) to unit with Wood Screws (short).



STEP 10


Attach Handles with Machine Screws.

Attach top unit to unit with Cam Locks.

Slide Drawer (V) into position.

Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit.




CARE INSTRUCTIONS

NEVER

allow liquids to remain on furniture. Absorption causes parts to warp and split and finishes to delaminate.

NEVER

use glass cleaners on finished furniture. Ammonia chemically attacks the finish.



Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.

PREVENT CRACKING



Do not place in direct sunlight.

PREVENT FADING



Do not write directly on surface.

PREVENT MARKING



Do not place hot objects on surface.

PREVENT FINISH DAMAGE



Do not use rubber based placemats.

PREVENT DISCOLORING



Do not use commercial waxes and polishes.

PREVENT YELLOWING

CLEAN

with a soft cloth moistened in lukewarm soap and water. Buff with a dry clean cloth.
