Please use this guide to ensure your new appliances will fit in their space properly. A measurement off by as little as 1/4 inch can turn the excitement of your new purchase into a major inconvenience. Double-checking your measurements will help to ensure a smooth purchase and delivery.

Measure the Space

Measuring the space is one of the most important steps before selecting a new washer and dryer

Measure the depth of the area where your washer and dryer will reside.

Right Side _____

Left Side _____



Measure the height of the space from the floor to the cabinet above if applicable. Measure both the left and right corners. This measurement is critical especially if you desire optional pedestals for front-load machines.

Right Corner _____

Left Corner _____



Measure the width of the space from any obstruction on the left to any obstruction on the right. Measure both the top and bottom of the area.

Obstacles

There may be obstacles that affect what style of washer and dryer will work in your home

Is your laundry area enclosed in a closet-like area? The doors may restrict the available depth for your new washer / dryer.

Walk the Path

Walking the path the installers will take is important to do before selecting a new washer and dryer

Measure any exterior doorways. The installers can remove the doors from the hinges if necessary.

Measure any interior doorways. Sometimes, interior doors are narrower than exterior doors.

Measure the stairway. Be sure to measure the width in multiple places especially if there is a turn.

Additional Issues

There are a few additional issues to address before you select a new washer and dryer

Please verify which laundry piece is on your right or left by facing the machines. Most common is for the washer to be on your left. Manufacturers produce the machines for this orientation. If your machines are the opposite, the doors will open inconveniently. It is possible to reverse the dryer door of most models and only a few washers. Which side is your washer?

Please verify if your dryer is gas or electric. A gas dryer has a normal 120v outlet. An electric dryer has a larger outlet with three or four prongs (holes).

All electric dryers do not come with a 220v cord. NFM can sell you a new 220v cord. Would you like to include a new cord on your order?

Do you have a gas line shutoff if you have a gas dryer?

A flexible vent tube carries the hot exhaust from the dryer to outside of the home. For safety and liability purposes, NFM insists that it is made of some type of metal. Is your vent tube made of metal?

Some homes require that the vent tube be routed from the side of the dryer. This requires additional procedures that a sales person can explain and set up. Does your dryer vent from the side?

- The delivery team will haul away your old units if it has been pre-arranged.
