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INTRODUCTION

This laptop offers different activities to introduce letters and words, numbers and counting, shapes, instruments, melodies and to see characters dancing. Get ready to learn some Spanish by exploring and learning with Dora!

Unlock the Packaging Locks:




- 1 Turn the packaging locks counterclockwise several times.
- Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

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ATTENTION:

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

ACTIVATE NORMAL PLAY MODE

Press and hold keys 1 and 6 for more than one second until you hear "Du Du" sounds to exit Try-Me Mode. Press the **On/Off Button** to turn the unit **On**.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Button

To turn the unit On, press the On/Off Button. Press the On/Off Button again to turn the unit Off.

2. Five Activity Buttons



Press an **Activity Button** to enter a category to choose an activity.

3. Number Buttons



Press a **Number Button** to learn about numbers, counting and shapes.

4. Letter Buttons



Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn about letters and words in English and Spanish.

5. Mouse

Move the **Mouse** left and right to choose and confirm selections.



6. Backpack Button



Press the Backpack Button to enter the object quiz game.

7. Dora Button



Press the **Dora Button** to learn about cartoon characters and personalized information.

8. Map Button



Press the **Map Button** to take an adventure on the map by answering questions.

9. Settings Button



Press the **Settings Button** to set the volume and LCD contrast level, and to customize the user's name, age, favorite food, instrument and cartoon character.

10. Help Button

Press the **Help Button** to repeat the current response or question.

11. Backlight On/Off Button



Press the Backlight On/Off Button to turn the LCD backlight On or Off.

12. Background Music On/Off Button



Press the Background Music On/Off Button to turn the background music On or Off.

13. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Dora More to Explore Learning Laptop** will shut **off** automatically after several minutes of no input. The unit can be turned **on** again by pressing the **On/Off Button**. The unit will also automatically turn **off** when the batteries are very low.

ACTIVITIES

1. Learn With Dora

This activity introduces numbers and counting, letters and words. Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn about uppercase and lowercase letters, and words. Press the **Number Buttons** to learn about numbers and counting.



2. Type With Dora

Users can practice typing words and expressions in this activity. Press the **Letter Buttons** to type words and expressions. Press the **Mouse** to currently typed letters.




3. Bridge Crossing

This is a quiz about uppercase and lowercase letters. There are two levels with 26 questions each. The questions in the first level are about uppercase letters, and those in the second level are about lowercase letters. Move the Mouse left or right to choose the correct letter and press the Mouse to confirm. Press a Letter Button to choose the correct letter.



4. Missing Letter

This activity contains two levels with 26 questions each. The questions in the first level are words in capital letters with the first letter missing, and those in the second level are words in capital letters with any one of the letters missing. Move the Mouse left or right to choose the correct letter and press the Mouse to confirm. Press a Letter Button to choose the correct letter.



5. Treature Hunt

This activity is a quiz about shapes. Move the Mouse left or right to choose and press the Mouse to confirm the answer. Press the Letter Buttons to hear letters. Press the Number Buttons to hear numbers.



6. Hangry Fish River

This activity is a quiz about counting numbers. Move the MOUSE up or down to play the game (avoid fish or obstacles in the river). After the game finishes, use the MOUSE or press a Number Button to answer a question about numbers. Move the MOUSE left or right to choose and press the MOUSE to confirm the answer.



7. Exploring Instruments

This activity is a quiz about instruments. Hear an instrument sound and its name, and then find it from several instruments. Move the Mouse left or right to choose and press the Mouse to confirm the answer. Press the Letter Buttons to hear letters. Press the Number Buttons to hear numbers.



8. Dance Party

Play music and change to different instruments in the music. Use the Mouse to choose one of the ten melodies to play. When the melody is playing, the screen will show a character dancing, Move the Mouse up or down and press it to add or remove instruments from the melody. Press the Letter Buttons to hear letters. Press the Number Buttons to hear numbers.



9. Spanish Discovery

Get introduced to Spanish words, letters, and numbers. Press the **Letter Buttons** to hear letters and words in English and then in Spanish. Press the **Number Buttons** to hear numbers in English and then Spanish.



10. Spanish Words

This activity is a quiz about Spanish words. Hear a word in Spanish, and then use the **Mouse** to choose the correct answer. Move the **Mouse** left or right to choose and press it to confirm the answer.



11. Map

Press the Map Button to answer quiz questions based on the location selected on the map. There are three locations on the map for each round. Users need to pass the locations one by one. Move the Mouse or press a Letter or Number Button to answer questions, depending on the activity.



There are a total of six locations: lake, bridge, mountain, beach, river and forest. Three of the locations will randomly appear on the map for each round.

Bridge: a question from Activity 3 will be given.

Mountain: a question from Activity 4 will be given.

Beach / Sea: a question from Activity 5 will be given.

River: a question from Activity 6 will be given.

Forest: a question from Activity 7will be given.

12. Backpack

Press the **Backpack Button** to answer questions about objects. Move the **Mouse** left or right to choose and press it to confirm the answer. Press the **Letter Buttons** to hear letters. Press the **Number Buttons** to hear numbers.



13. Meet Dora's Friends

Press the **Dora Button** to meet characters from the Dora series and personalized information set by users. Move the **Mouse** left or right and press the **Mouse** to confirm a character to learn about. Press the **Letter Buttons** to hear letters. Press the **Number Buttons** to hear numbers.



Customization

Press the **Settings Button**, and then move the **Mouse** to choose and enter the customization activity to set the user's name, age, and favorite food, instrument and character. The customized information will be shown in Activity 13.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
