

Unlock the Packaging Locks



- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees counterclockwise.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.


Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 3 new AA (LR6/AM-3)
 batteries, following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

IMPORTANT: INFORMATIONS CONCERNANT LES PILES

Les piles fournies avec le produit permettent de tester le jouet en magasin mais ne sont pas des piles longue durée.

- Mettre en place les piles ou les accumulateurs en respectant les polarités + et -.
- Ne pas mélanger des piles ou des accumulateurs neufs avec des usagés.
- Ne pas mélanger différents types de piles : alcalines, zinccarbone et rechargeables.
- Seules des piles du type recommandé doivent être utilisées.
- Ne pas mettre les bornes d'une pile ou d'un accumulateur en court-circuit (en reliant directement le + et le –).
- Retirer les piles ou les accumulateurs en cas de non-utilisation prolongée.
- Enlever les piles ou les accumulateurs usagés du jouet.
- · Ne les jeter ni au feu ni dans la nature.

PILES RECHARGEABLES

- Enlever, lorsque c'est possible, les accumulateurs du jouet pour les recharger.
- Les accumulateurs ne doivent être chargés que sous la surveillance d'un adulte.
- Ne pas tenter de recharger des piles non rechargeables.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Mode Selector

Slide the On/Off/Mode Selector to choose one of five game modes.
Slide the On/Off/Mode Selector to the Off O position to turn Off the unit.



2. Letter Buttons

Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn letters, phonics and words or to answer related questions. The **LED Light** will light up when pressing the **Letter Buttons**.



3. Music Button



Press the **Music Button** to play melodies and the **LED Light** will synchronize with it.



4. Volume Button



Press the **Volume Button** to adjust the sound level.



5. Character Buttons

Press the **Character Buttons** to learn phonics, letters, spelling and fun facts about the PAW Patrol Pups.



6. Mission Button

Press the **Mission Button** to learn letters and words, as well as play guessing and memory games.



7. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically shut Off after approximately 90 seconds without input. The Light-Up Missions Pup Pad can be woken up again by sliding the On/Off/ Mode Selector to select between game modes. The Light-Up Missions Pup Pad will also automatically turn Off when battery power is very low.

NOTE: If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Letters and Sounds



Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn phonics and letters with **Ryder**. Press the **Mission Button** to call out a letter and press the **Letter Buttons** to answer.

2. Word Fun



Press the **Letter Buttons** to learn the words with **Ryder**. Press the **Mission Button** to call out a word and press the **Letter Buttons** to answer.

3. Spelling Guide



Press the **Letter Buttons** to select a word and then press the light-up letters to spell with **Ryder**. Press the **Mission Button** to play the instructions for help.

4. Guess It



Ryder will ask questions about the words and then press the **Letter Buttons** to answer. Press the **Mission Button** to repeat the questions.

5. Path Finder



The **Letter Buttons** will be lit up as a path. Press the **Letter Buttons** to count. Press the **Mission Button** to light up a path and then disappear. Press the **Letter Buttons** to repeat the path.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Slide to any mode. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
